Description:

The Astoria Warming Center is a low-barrier, seasonal shelter and off-season resource center for unsheltered people in Clatsop County.

Duties/Responsibilities:

Facilities Management

- Assures proper intake of non-cash donations, including offering receipts, taking inventory, and coordinating proper storage.
- Maintains good stewardship of the facilities and appreciates the multi-purpose nature of the non-cash donations space.

Volunteer Management

- Communicates effectively with all volunteers aiding in non-cash donation support
- Makes sure volunteers are maintaining proper logs and organizational systems
- Provides conflict resolution for any dispute between volunteers or between volunteers and guests

Cash Donations Management

- Coordinates deposits with Executive Director and maintains records with Bookkeeper and Treasurer
- Maintains Donor List of addresses and email addresses
- Assists with year-end thank you notes, working with the Executive Director to assure timely processing
- Tally results of mail-in campaigns and provide reports to the Fundraising Committee

Additional duties, as needed

- Answer inquiries regarding donations
- Coordinate/assist with community donation efforts, such as drop boxes
- Working under the supervision of the ED, send a monthly donation summary to the Treasurer

Qualifications

- As a prerequisite, a successful candidate must believe in the mission of the Astoria Warming Center and the dignity of unsheltered persons.
- Strong organization skills and a knack for identifying and sustaining efficient systems.
- Attention to detail and a propensity for excelling at repetitive tasks.
- Good management skills and communication with volunteers and guests.
- Ability to create and maintain professional boundaries with volunteers and guests.
- Self-driven and requiring minimal day-to-day supervision.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, Google Drive, Google Sheets, and Google Docs.

With reasonable accommodations:

- Ability to lift 20 lbs unaided.
- A valid driver's license or the ability to walk from the Center to the bank (3 blocks)

Pay

This is a part-time position at \$15/hour. Until November 15th, it has Hazard Pay of \$2/hr. This will be reassessed at that date based on public health concerns. This position can be combined with other part-time positions at the Astoria Warming Center.
